FESTIVAL POLICY

- Food and Beverage carry-ins are not allowed in concert area.
- Bring your own lawn chair for seating in general concert area.
- All people attending Country Fest do so at their own risk. No liability is assumed by owners, managers, promoters, sponsors or others associated with the event.
- Country Fest will take place RAIN or SHINE. All acts advertised have confirmed their appearance at Country Fest; however, acts are subject to change without notice. There will be no refunds or exchanges resulting from the failure of any act to appear at the festival. ALL SALES ARE FINAL. Country Fest is not responsible for lost, stolen, or forgotten tickets or passes, or replacement of armbands.
- Roadside sales and any other scalped tickets will NOT be honored.
- All Armbands are non-transferrable and will be registered to the individual that purchased the ticket.
- Pets are strictly forbidden in the concert area. Dogs outside the concert area must be chained, leashed and watered at all times. Please respect your neighbors and clean up after your pet.
- Your car pass MUST be attached to the driver side of your vehicle windshield - If you haven't attached it, the attendants at the gate entrance will attach it to your windshield.
- Vehicles are subject for search upon entry and while vehicles are on the festival grounds at any time. Festival Staff will be searching for items such as fireworks, weapons, illegal drugs, off road vehicles & for people sneaking in illegally. Anyone on the Festival grounds without the proper ticket/armband is subject to a fine of \$1000 for trespassing.
- Any violations of festival policies will be subject to having your arm band removed and being escorted from the Festival grounds and subject to fine according to state and local ordinances.

FESTIVAL POLICY CONTINUED

- Children ages 16 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
- Hearing protection is strongly suggested for all festival attendees, especially for children.
- No photo, video, or audio recording equipment (no detachable lenses, tripods, big zooms or commercial-use rigs) aside from cell phones are allowed.
