



# 2022 FESTIVAL POLICY

- ▶ Food and beverage carry-ins are not allowed in concert area.
- ▶ Bring your own lawn chair for seating in general concert area.
- ▶ All people attending Country Fest do so at their own risk. No liability is assumed by owners, managers, promoters, sponsors, or others associated with the event.
- ▶ **Country Fest will take place RAIN or SHINE.** All acts advertised have confirmed their appearance at Country Fest; however, acts are subject to change without notice. There will be no refunds or exchanges resulting from the failure of any act to appear at the festival. ALL SALES ARE FINAL. Country Fest is not responsible for lost, stolen, or forgotten tickets or passes, or replacement of armbands
- ▶ Roadside sales and any other scalped tickets will NOT be honored.
- ▶ All armbands are non-transerrable and will be registered to the individual that purchased the ticket.
- ▶ Pets are strictly forbidden in the concert area. Dogs outside the concert area must be chained, leashed, and watered at all times. Please respect your neighbors and clean up after your pets.
- ▶ Your car pass MUST be attached to the driver side of your vehicle windshield. If you haven't attached it, the attendants at the gate entrance will attach it to your windshield.
- ▶ **Vehicles are subject to search upon entry and while vehicles are on the festival grounds at any time. Festival staff will be searching for items such as fireworks, illegal drugs, off-road vehicles and for any people sneaking in illegally. Anyone on the festival grounds without a proper ticket or armband is subject to a fine of \$1000 for trespassing.**
- ▶ Any violations of festival policies will be subject to have your armband removed and being escorted from the festival grounds and subject to a fine according to state and local ordinances.
- ▶ Any unauthorized use or resell at Country Fest branding or Country Fest logos is strictly prohibited. Any violation of this will result in legal action.
- ▶ Children ages 16 and under must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
- ▶ Hearing protection is strongly recommended for all festival attendees, especially for children.
- ▶ No photo, video, or audio recording equipment (no detachable lenses, tripods, big zooms, or commercial-use rigs) aside from cellphones allowed.

# FESTIVAL POLICY

- I understand that while Chippewa Valley Music Festivals Inc and Fun In The Sun Inc (Seller) has undertaken reasonable steps to lessen the risk of the transmission of COVID-19 in connection with the Festival for which I am purchasing tickets (the "Festival"), there are still risks for attending the Festival. I understand that the World Health Organization has classified the COVID-19 outbreak as a pandemic and that COVID-19 is a highly contagious and dangerous disease, and that being in contact with a person or object carrying COVID-19 may result in significant personal injury or death.
- I am fully aware that participation in the Festival carries inherent risks related to COVID-19 transmission that cannot be eliminated, regardless of the care taken to avoid such risks. Inherent risks may include, but are not limited to: (1) coming in contact with individuals or objects that are carrying COVID-19, (2) the risk of transmitting or contracting COVID-19, and (3) injuries and complications ranging in severity, including death, resulting directly or indirectly from COVID-19 itself, the treatment thereof, or long-lasting effects of COVID-19.
- I hereby voluntarily accept and assume all risk of loss, personal injury, sickness, death, damage, and expense arising from such inherent risks and exposure to COVID-19 and release Seller from any and all liability. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless seller for all damages I incur, or damage to third-parties as a result of my attendance at the festival, including minor children under my custody, care, and control, as a result of such inherent risks and exposure to COVID-19 at the Festival.
- I further attest that if I test positive for COVID-19 or I am exposed to COVID-19 or in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19 within fourteen (14) days prior to my anticipated attendance of the Festival, I will not attend the Festival.
